CUTTING

Boo

White

From the white, or your ghost fabric, cut:

- 32 squares $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$
- 4 squares $2\frac{7}{8}" \times 2\frac{7}{8}"$
- 2 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

Black

From the black fabric, or your background, cut:

- 68 squares $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$
- 4 squares $2\frac{7}{8}" \times 2\frac{7}{8}"$
- 2 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

Ghoul

White

From the white, or your ghost fabric, cut:

- 31 squares $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$
- 5 squares $2\frac{7}{8}" \times 2\frac{7}{8}"$
- 2 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

Black

From the black fabric, or your background, cut:

- 68 squares $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$
- 5 squares $2\frac{7}{8}" \times 2\frac{7}{8}"$
- 2 rectangles $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

Orange

From the orange fabric, or your bow fabric, cut:

- 2 squares $2\frac{7}{8}" \times 2\frac{7}{8}"$

PIECE

Eyes, Feet and Bow

Eyes

Pair the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " black and white rectangles right sides together. Piece them together using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seams open. Make 2 eyes for each ghost.

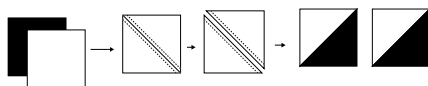


MAKE 2 EYES FOR EACH GHOST

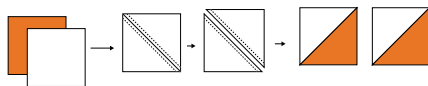
Feet and Bow

Next, make the Half Square Triangle blocks for the ghost "feet" and the little ghouls bow.

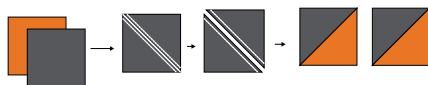
1. On the wrong side of all the $2\frac{7}{8}$ " white squares and one $2\frac{7}{8}$ " orange square draw a diagonal line.



2. With right sides together pair the unmarked orange square with a marked white square; pair the marked orange square with a black square; then pair the rest of the white squares with the black squares.



3. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from either side of the marked line.



4. Cut apart along the line. Press the seams to the dark side.

MAKE THE HST BLOCKS

5. Trim all the HSTs to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. You will only need 1 orange and white HST and 1 orange and black HST. Make 8 black and white HSTs for each ghost.

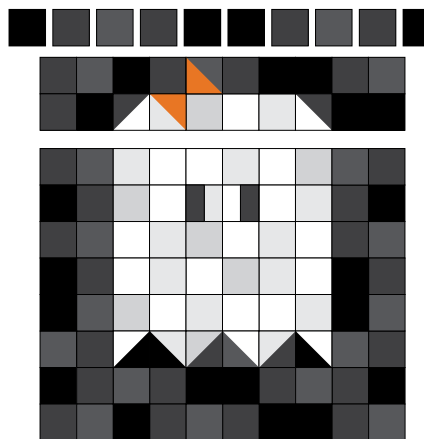
BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Starting with the Ghoul, lay out your HST blocks and black and white squares on a design surface.

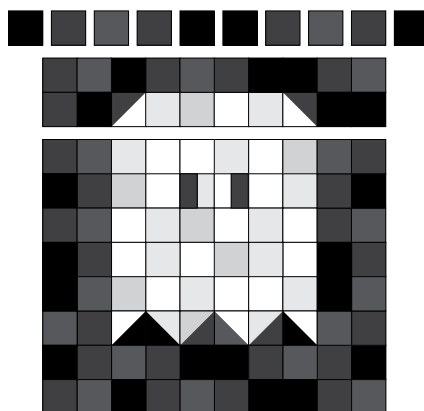
2. Then sew the squares and HST blocks together into rows. Press the seams to alternating sides. Press odd rows to the right; press even rows to the left.

3. Then sew the rows together to make your little “Ghoul” block. Press seams open or to one side.

4. Repeat the process to make the “Boo” ghost block.



ASSEMBLE GHOUL



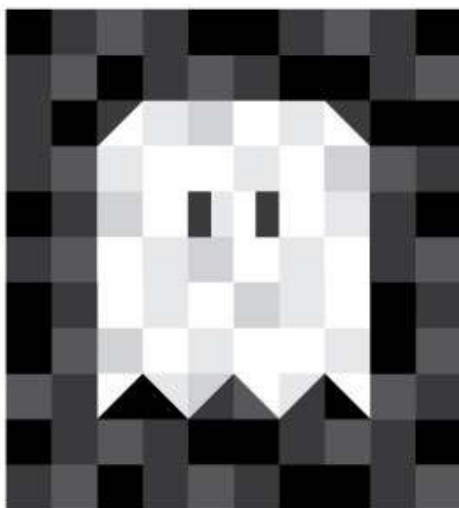
ASSEMBLE BOO

MATERIALS

- ½ yard assorted black fabrics
- ½ yard assorted white fabrics
